
**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY
SCHEDULING ORDER DEADLINES**

On this day the Defendant, with the concurrence of the Plaintiff, moved the Court to stay and suspend the deadlines currently in effect under the most recent Scheduling Order entered herein on July 27, 2007, and it appearing to the Court that good cause exists for said Motion, it is accordingly

ORDERED that the deadlines currently in effect under the Scheduling Order entered herein on July 27, 2007, beginning with the October 26, 2007 due date for Discovery Completion, and continuing up to and including the Trial Date of February 20, 2008, be, and the same hereby are, suspended and stayed pending notification by the parties as to the outcome of the Mediation scheduled herein on December 20, 2007.
