disposition, as the case may be. Further, the magistrate judge is directed to conduct as soon as practicable a screening of the complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a) and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) (1996) and to make a recommendation for disposition.

The clerk is directed to transmit copies of this order of to the pro se plaintiff, to the defendants, and to any counsel of record herein and to the Honorable John S. Kaull, United States Magistrate Judge.
